CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not mix this algaecide with soap or other cleaners. Do not premix with other water treating chemicals. These chemicals must be handled separately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Dilute appropriate amount of product with at least nine parts water and pour directly into pool along the edges while the filter and pump are in operation. To allow time for even distribution in pool water, bathers must allow 10 minutes after treatment before entering pool.

INITIAL APPLICATION: Free of Visible Algae/Start of Season: Apply 2 oz of this product per 5000 gallons of pool water (or equivalent) under sunny conditions for most effective results.

If Algae Growth is Visible: Apply initial dose, then vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If pool is heavy with algae growth, first brush algae spots, vacuum, clean and scrub the pool walls. Apply initial dose, then vacuum remaining algae debris.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Apply 1 oz of product per 5000 gallons of pool water (or equivalent) every 5 to 7 days. Note: After heavy or prolonged rainfall, high prevailing temperatures, or heavy swimming use, add the maintenance dose more frequently.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center immediately for treatment advice. Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and rinse slowly with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present after 5 minutes then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
