2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

IMMEDIATE CONCERNS: Corrosive to eyes and skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mists.

POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS

EYES: Very hazardous in case of eye contact (irritant, corrosive). Inflammation of the eye is characterized by redness, watering and itching.

SKIN: Hazardous in case of skin contact (corrosive, irritant). Skin contact may produce burns. Skin inflammation is characterized by itching, scaling, reddening, or occasionally blistering.


